MISSION STATEMENT

St. Paul's is a Christ-centered school that inspires and challenges students to be courageous leaders.

PK 3- Age 3 by Sept 1st 3 day program meets Mon, Wed, Thurs 8:30-11:30 AM 5 day Mon-Friday 8:30-11:30 AM

Our program utilizes a developmentally appropriate approach focusing physically on large and fine motor skills and socially on cooperative play. The 3's curriculum is set up to expose children to a wide variety of learning styles and concepts. Each day children are exposed to the calendar, weather, numbers, letters and Bible time. Children develop their foundational education skills through structured activities, classroom projects, and self-regulated play with peers. We strive to foster and encourage each child's natural progression of development, while exposing them to a language rich environment in the areas of beginning math concepts, fine motor activities, gross motor skills, art, dramatic play, Bible stories, music and social interactions.

PK 4 Age 4 by Sept 1st 5 day program Monday–Friday from 8:30-11:30AM or 12:30-3:30 PM

Our Pre K 4 class is designed to offer children the academic and Biblical foundations needed to be successful learners. Academic concepts such as counting, letters, numbers, and writing are introduced using multi-sensory approaches. As a natural progression of development occurs, focus is placed on the child's individual growth and development. Children are encouraged to explore their environment and begin to cultivate their love of learning at an early age. St. Paul's provides a language rich environment and utilizes phonics based reading materials from Super Kids Reading.

Kindergarten St. Paul's Kindergarten is a full day educational program. The curriculum includes a phonics based reading program, language arts, mathematics, science, religion, and foreign language. Whole group instruction as well as small group learning centers are utilized. Continual social and educational training is provided to build a strong foundation for first grade. Utilizing a proven phonics based, literature rich program from Super Kids, children learn the skills necessary to read. Daily curriculum also includes Bible stories and faith building activities, math number sense and computation development, science, social studies, art, P.E., music, and technology.

Elementary School Grades 1 through 5 Courses of study include religion, mathematics, language arts, science, physical education, social studies, Spanish, chorus, band, art, and physical education. In addition to the learning that takes place in the classroom, students also take field trips into our community to enhance their learning. The faculty is dedicated to providing our students with a strong spiritual base combined with a competitive academic program.

Middle School Grades 6 through 8 St. Paul's has a departmentalized middle school that gives an academically enriched program through specialized instruction. Academic curriculum includes mathematics, literature, English grammar, writing, history/geography, science, and Spanish. In addition to the academic curriculum middle school students have art, physical education, music, choral music and an optional band program. Daily religion classes, devotions, and weekly chapel services foster the student's spiritual growth. This academic program, combined with daily spiritual development, makes for an excellent foundation to be built upon in high school. Class trips and organized group activities expand the student's horizons and enhance social development.
